- **1.** South Africa must count the cost of this violence: lawlessness: riots: and crime and corruption.
- 2. More than 200 shopping malls were clearly targeted and then destroyed in this wave of crime.
- 3. More than 45 000 businesses in Durban alone were destroyed in this wave of lawless terrorism.
- 4. South Africa must count the cost of this loss to the economy and also begin to realise the cause.
- 5. More than 1.5 million people have been left without an income and it is devastating for them.
- 6. More than 800 stores and retailers have been looted 200 000 people have lost SASSA grants!
- 7. South Africa must count the cost of this rioting and more than 36 Cash Build stores destroyed.

South Africa must begin to count the cost to the economy by terrorism and then assess the cause of it.

- **1.** South Africa must begin to assess the damage and understand reason for this disaster in 2021.
- 2. More than 550 squatter camps are all situated in KZN alone and also more than 900 in Gauteng.
- 3. More than R16 Billion in stock was stolen and Mr Price lost more than 109 retail outlets in 2021.
- 4. South Africa must begin to realise the extent of the destruction and realise the loss to economy.
- 5. More than R5 Billion was stolen through all looting but also more than R3 trillion in corruptions.
- 6. More than 353 000 tons of sugar was destroyed: and 535 Mr Price stores were damaged in this.
- 7. South Africa must begin to understand the impact of all violence on 34 sectors of the economy.

South Africa must begin to count the cost to the country by this violence: corruption and also all crime.

- **1.** South Africa must know the truth about the nature of the crime before a solution can be found.
- 2. The country has witnessed the greatest heist or planned destruction in the history of a country.
- 3. This is not an ordinary act of looting by poverty-stricken or hungry people from informal camps.
- 4. South Africa must understand that truth about the planning that went into these acts of crime!
- 5. The country has witnessed the result of organised crime and corruption that has not been told.
- 6. This is not an ordinary act of political and civil unrest over that arrest of the former president.
- 7. South Africa must realise that truth about the acts and omissions and actions about the crime!

South Africa must begin to count the cost of ignorance and propaganda - relating to the acts of crime.

- **1.** South Africa has been deceived: betrayed and plundered by people of influence in these acts.
- 2. More than 1.5 million rounds of ammunition and automatic weapons were stolen in Mobeni.
- 3. Under SAPS protection this was achieved and Value Logistics were cleaned out in other depots.
- 4. More than just food was stolen and all long-life bulk food was stolen to sustain a military army.
- 5. Under SAPS and private security protection Makro and Game were targeted for camping gear.
- 6. More than just electronic and surveillance equipment was stolen from all these retail outlets.
- 7. South Africa has been misled into believing that only these poor and political activists did this!

South Africa must begin to count the cost of apathy and silence to the levels of corruption and crime!

- **1.** South Africa must be informed about that military-style control centres were established in it.
- 2. Cameras and computers and solar panels were stolen from Game: Makro and Musket to do it.
- **3.** Covid 19 curfews were used to rob the ATMS and all the big stores and warehouses at night.
- 4. South Africa must be informed about the precision and the burning of malls and the factories.
- 5. Combat weapons and incendiary grenades were used to ignite the flames and looting follows.
- 6. Conclusions are that Dunlop tyres and other factories were all cleaned out but few recovered.
- 7. South Africa must be informed that Dischem and pharmaceutical suppliers were also targeted.
